Examples of priorities raised by Regional Leaders in the Northern Rivers:

- Aligning Regional Leaders with broader Corporate Social Responsibility and local/regional purpose entities
 - (e.g., Byron Bay Wildlife Sanctuary, CASPA, Fletcher St Cottage)
- Supporting the development of the region's Future Leaders (workforce development and retention in the region)
- Advocate for the development of the Northern Rivers Regional Growth Strategy, with business and industry centric insights and key decision-making information/foresight for the next 20 years
- Focus on innovation and technology enablement for future industry development and support business transition to the next economy
- Elevating the Northern Rivers NSW brand and brand pillars (visitor attraction, investment, provenance, liveability) with the connection to attracting skilled labour to the region
- Influencing regional investment in enabling infrastructure to improve regional economic development opportunities, market improvements and cost savings for business (address mobile black spots, industrial land supply and housing)
- Advocating for NSW procurement with a focus on NSW and regionally based businesses to be preferenced by Government
- Reform the NSW workers compensation scheme lessen the impact on employers and address the poor performance of iCare
- A focus on events with a technology underpinning e.g., Tech and Innovation Summit, Hackathon, Next Gen engineers
- Business NSW to explore funding or partnerships that would support a 'world class tech event' (scope out AgriTech innovation project e.g., Northern Rivers Shark Tank)



Examples of priorities raised by Regional Leaders in the Northern Rivers:

- Roundtable and white paper on a new system for planning and development (fast lane for business development applications) as
 part of a strategic sustainable employment strategy for the region
- Promote investment in town and village renewal projects across the region to support business and community development opportunities and visitor dispersal, including maximizing the Northern Rivers Rail Trail connectivity
- Advocating a fresh approach to our regional road network infrastructure renewal along the lines of Transport for NSW's predictive
 and preventative maintenance program with longer term outcomes for Councils and business (less tear and less adhoc repair)
- Develop an Integrated Transport Plan to match the population growth of the region and resulting density of living
- Activation of industrial and employment land
- Advancing global connections for the Northern Rivers with a view to a Northern Rivers expo presence
- Supporting and profiling carbon neutral and circular economy initiatives in the Northern Rivers with the Regional Leaders group –
 an opportunity to celebrate success and align with a broader ESG agenda and investment for business
- Opportunities to improve connections with other leaders and key stakeholders within the business community across the thought
 leadership events
